#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Precaution: 0-0-25 GreeneKick™ is a highly concentrated material. If applying in combination with other materials, a compatibility test is recommended to avoid potential incompatibilities. Some complex concentrated tank mixes could show phytotoxicity when applied in very low water volumes during periods of high heat and humidity. Greene-Kick™ remains in the liquid phase on leaf surfaces for a prolonged period of time and demonstrates spray adjuvant properties.

## **PRO DIRECTIONS**

SHAKE WELL! The mixed product should be agitated prior to and during application.

Turf grass, Tees, greens & approaches, lawn, landscape turf and sports turf: Apply at a rate of 2-5 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. During periods of active growth or stress, apply every 14 days to 21 days in a minimum of 1.5 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.

General landscape and nursery greenhouse plant, application either as foliar or drench: Dilute at a rate of 1-2 ounces per 3 gallons of water. Apply with good coverage to the point of runoff every 14-21 days for best results.

**Arbor care:** Dilute at a rate of 2-3 ounces per 3 gallons of water. Apply as a soil drench in the fall or during periods of stress.

**Lawns (blackout):** Apply at a rate of 2-5 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. During periods of active growth or stress, apply every 14 days to 21 days in a minimum of 1.5 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.

### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

**0-0-25 GreeneKick™** *Potassium Turf Fertilizer* is a clear to gray, liquid concentrated formula which provides 100% soluble potassium to your plants. It is derived from high quality Potassium Carbonate which helps correct potassium deficiency in plants, as well as improve stress tolerance. It can be applied through foliar and root feeding to provide dual efficacy during growing season to achieve faster results. It does not contain chlorides which usually cause salt buildup, and has a low salt index to avoid over saturation of soil. It is recommended for turf, ornamentals and trees.

Apply when potassium deficiency is present or as a regularly scheduled potassium application as part of a fertility program. **GreeneKick™** can be mixed with slightly acidic, neutral and alkaline solutions.

Storage: Store in a safe manner. Store in original labeled container only in a cool place away from direct sunlight. Keep tightly sealed when not in use. Apply in accordance with best management practices (BMP's) established by your Cooperative Extension Service. Observe any State or Local fertilizer application regulations. Caution: Apply only to turf, plants, and soil. If plants are flowering, apply to base of the plant to avoid staining of blooms. Keep out of Reach of Children.
